RE-OPENING OF TRANSFER STATIONS TO RESIDENTIAL DROP-OFF

Corner Brook, NL, 26 February 2021 - The Western Regional Service Board, operators of Western Regional Waste Management, announces the re-opening of transfer stations to residential drop-off effective Saturday, 27 February 2021.

Due to the move to Alert Level Four in our region, WRWM wishes to advise the public that all six transfer stations (Long Range, Burgeo, Bay St. George, Hampden, Southwest Coast, and Wild Cove) will be opening to residential drop-off starting Saturday, 27 February 2021.

At this time, the Administration Office in Corner Brook will remain closed to the public until further notice. Our staff will remain available via phone and email during regular operating hours.

GUIDELINES:

- Please follow the direction of the designated spotters on site as to where to drop off your specific waste material. With respect of other users, please ensure your waste material is sorted within your vehicle for quick offloading at designated areas onsite.
- While on site, residents are required to maintain safe physical distancing of 2m (6 ft) from staff and others.
- The sites may be busy at this time, so please be patient, remain in your vehicles, and anticipate delays.
- Your residential account must be in good standing before visiting the station. To avoid delays, please have your card ready before you enter the site.
- If you are feeling unwell, please stay home.
