

Due to the COVID-19 pandemic, access to the residential drop-off at all six Western Regional Service Board Transfer Stations had been temporarily suspended. Beginning the week of May 25, 2020, the WRSB will be reopening their residential drop-off areas with the following two-week transition plan.

Burgoe and Long Range Transfer Stations:

Open to residents during their regular operating hours as of the week beginning May 25.

Southwest Coast and White Bay South (Hampden) Transfer Stations:

Open to residents during their regular operating hours (Monday to Saturday) effective May 25, 2020. Residents will be permitted entrance onto the site using the Alphabetical order listed below.

Wild Cove and St. George's Transfer Stations:

Open to residents during the weeks of May 25-29 and June 1-5 (Monday to Friday) using the Alphabetical order listed below. For these 10 days, the hours of operation for these two sites will be extended to 8am – 7pm.

For Saturday, May 30 and Saturday, June 6, these two sites will be **CLOSED TO RESIDENTIAL DROP-OFF** and will be open for **COMMERCIAL USERS ONLY**.

We are expecting a high volume of visitors at the transfer stations during this period, so please visit **only if necessary**.

To control the expected number of visitors at the **Wild Cove, St. Georges, Southwest Coast and White Bay South Transfer Stations**, we ask that users of these sites visit on the designated day based on the first letter of their surname:

MONDAY	Surnames A-E
TUESDAY	Surnames F-J
WEDNESDAY	Surnames K-O
THURSDAY	Surnames P-T
FRIDAY	Surnames U-Z

GUIDELINES:

- Please follow the direction of the designated spotters on site as to where to drop off your specific waste material. With respect of other users, please ensure your waste material is sorted within your vehicle for quick offloading at designated areas onsite.
- While on site, residents are required to maintain safe physical distancing of 2m (6 ft) from staff and others.
- The sites may be busy at this time, so please be patient, remain in your vehicles, and anticipate delays.
- Your residential account must be in good standing before visiting the station. To avoid delays, please have your card ready before you enter the site.
- If you are feeling unwell, please stay home.
